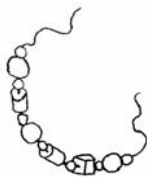





# Rainbow Bead Necklace

## Level B instructions



One of the special aspects of the Noah story is the beautiful rainbow. Wearing this necklace can be a reminder of the Lord's promise that He will always take care of them. Please supervise the little ones carefully with this project. The beads could be a choking hazard!

### Supplies included:

-  1 lace
-  7 plain beads
-  6 beads in rainbow colors

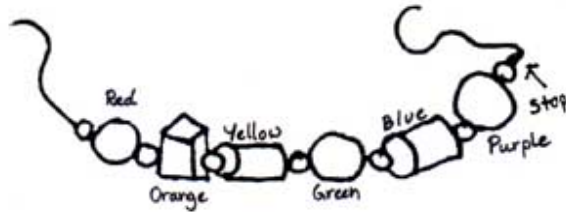
### Project instructions:

#### Rainbow necklace

- 1) Start the necklace by tying a knot about 8 inches from one end of the lace. This will act as a "stop" so the rest of the beads won't slide off.
- 2) Depending upon your children's fine motor skills:
  - o They may string the beads onto the shoelace themselves. It may be helpful to hold the string end up so your children can place the beads onto the lace.
  - o Hold the bead as they push the lace through it.
  - o Another way is for you to push the lace mostly through and let your children pull it out from the other side of the bead.



- 3) Pass the beads to your children in the order of the rainbow colors, alternating the uncolored beads with the colored ones as shown. End with the other small bead. (It's okay if they choose to put the beads in a different pattern.)



- 4) Once all the beads are on, tie a knot after the last bead, then double knot the ends together to finish the necklace.

**Activity instructions:**

Help your children learn the colors of the rainbow by playing with the necklace. Ask your children to look for other things that are the same colors. *Who made all these colors for us? Why did the Lord make a rainbow?*

Store the rainbow necklace in the creation box when not in use.
