

A Conjugal Love Collage Mural

The chaste delights of conjugal love in heaven are represented by gardens and fields of flowers, aromas of fruits and fragrances of flowers, and animals such as lambs, young goats, doves, and birds of paradise.

(see Conjugal Love 430)

Make a mural picturing the various ways that conjugal love (or the delights of conjugal love) are pictured in heaven.

Project A: Using Pictures and Stickers

Suggested Materials:

sheet of poster board or lightweight cardboard
pictures from bulb or flower catalogs
stickers of rainbows and animals
pictures of animals and flowers from calendars
glue
glitter

Procedure:

1. Choose pictures to glue onto the paper.
2. Add stickers and glitter as desired.
3. Add a text slip or title such as: **How Conjugal Love Is Pictured in Heaven**

Project B: Using Torn Paper

Suggested Materials:

sheet of poster board or lightweight cardboard
tissue paper of various colors
optional: cotton balls
glue

Preparation: Teacher sketches the picture ahead of time.

Procedure:

1. Children fill in the picture by gluing torn pieces of tissue paper onto the mural.
2. Use flat pieces of tissue paper to make rainbows, green grass, etc.
3. Could try crunching white tissue paper for lambs or use cotton balls.
4. Crunch up pieces of colored tissue paper to make flowers.
5. Add a text slip or title such as: **How Conjugal Love Is Pictured in Heaven**
