

## LESSON 5 – CASCADE NEW CHURCH SUNDAY SCHOOL

Text: Crossing the Red Sea – Exodus 14

### Recitation:

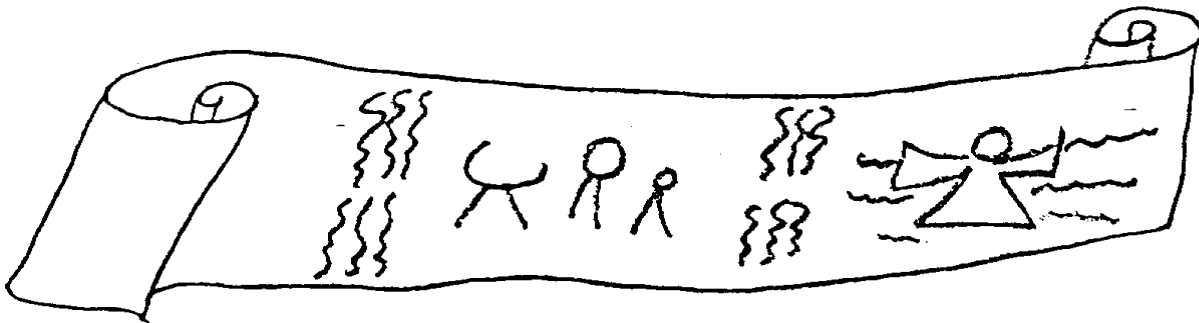
"Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. The Lord will fight for you" (*Exodus* 14:13-14).

### Themes:

1. Does the Lord fight for you?
2. If you ever feel afraid, remember to ask the Lord, "Please fight for me," and He will Watch.

### Activity:

The goal is to make a great mural of this story on a 10-12 foot roll of white paper about 18 inches wide. Spread the paper out on the table and give each child about a foot or so of space to draw on. Each child chooses one of the 8-10 scenes from the story. (Suggestions: verses 5, 7-8, 10, 20, 21, 22, 23, 25, 27, and 31) Make a division line between each scene using a "wavy" type stencil. The wavy lines can be colored red for



"pillar of fire" and blue for "pillar of cloud." Each child signs their work and text slips can be glued underneath to retell the story. Attaching 7/8" dowels, rolling it up and tying it with blue cord with tassels will make it a finished product to keep and reuse.

Adaptations for Toddlers:

Use a "sea" of blue Lego's to divide for some Lego Egyptians in chariots to chase some Lego Israelites across.

Also do a trick using centrifugal force to give them some idea of waters dividing and showing dry land. Fill a large plastic bowl with a few inches of water. Float a smaller bowl in this. Put an inch of blue colored water in it. Stir inner bowl with spoon. As inner bowl spins, the blue water climbs the bowl and leaves a bare spot.
