

Celebrating the Harvest in Ancient Israel

The Lord commanded the Children of Israel to make special feasts to the Lord. This project shows men bringing gifts to the high priest as the women and children look on.

Materials

crayons, colored pencils, or paints
scissors
glue or tape

Procedure

1. Color the figures with crayons, colored pencils, or paints.
2. Carefully cut out the figures along the heavy black lines.
3. With sharp scissors, cut along the two double straight lines on the background page making the “stage”. Then fold up the bottom part of the page along the dotted line.
4. Fold the base tab of the priest *back* and glue the base on the rectangle marked with a “P”.
5. Fold *back* the base tab of the group of women and children and glue to the base marked “C”.
6. Fold the base tabs *forward* for the two men who are carrying harvest gifts. Slip the tabs into the top slit on the background, and out again through the lower slit. Now you can use the tabs to move the men forward toward the priest, as if they were carrying their gifts to the Lord.
