

Hearts Knit Together

[T]he soul of Jonathan was knit to the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul (1 Sam. 18:1).

Directions: Photocopy hearts onto heavy paper such as cover stock or card stock. Cut out the hearts, and use a hole punch to make holes just inside the perimeter—where the little circles are. Lay the two hearts together and use a threaded yarn to sew the two hearts together—illustrating the friendship of Jonathan and David. (Note: You could also use the heart as a pattern to make hearts on poster board and then hole punch.
