

Decorate Easter Eggs

Because eggs symbolize the renewal of life, decorating eggs is a wonderful tradition at Easter time, when we celebrate the Lord's triumphant resurrection and salvation of the human race.

Here are a few ideas for adding a spiritual element to your Easter egg designs:

- Dye the eggs with cheerful colors because Easter is a happy time.
- Children might want to use a wax crayon to draw a picture of the sun, a butterfly, or a dove on an egg before coloring it. Or draw the picture with a marker after dyeing the egg.
- You may also want to picture the cross as a symbol of the Lord's victory over the hells in His last temptation.
- Another way to decorate the eggs is to use a wax crayon (white or clear works best) to write words on the eggs before putting them in the colored dye. These words might include:

Savior

Rejoice!

Easter

Peace to you!

Victory!

Redeemer

Love
