

Angels with You

Make 2 angels out of clothespins and slip them over the neck of your shirt or dress so that you remember that the Lord keeps angels near you at all times, protecting you and helping you do what is good. Think about these angels being like the cherubim above the Ark.

Materials:

wooden clothespins
fabric scraps, tissue paper, ribbon, yarn, *etc.*
marker, pen, or pencil if you want to draw a face

Procedure:

1. Make a robe or gown for your angel.
2. If you want to have the angel's arms showing, you might want to use a pipe cleaner to make the arms after making the gown.
3. Make wings for your angel, to remind you of the wings of the cherubim picturing the way the Lord protects us.
4. You may wish to add other details, such as hair, eyes, and mouth.

Enjoying the Angels:

Younger children may want to carry the angels with them, slipping the clothespin over the top edge of a shirt or dress.

Older children could stand the angels up, using wooden rings (clothespin doll stands) or balls of clay.

OR use fish line or gold thread to suspend the angels from the ceiling above your worship center or in your room.
