

Make Two Wings

I will abide in Your tabernacle forever;
I will trust in the shelter of Your wings.
(Psalm 61:4)

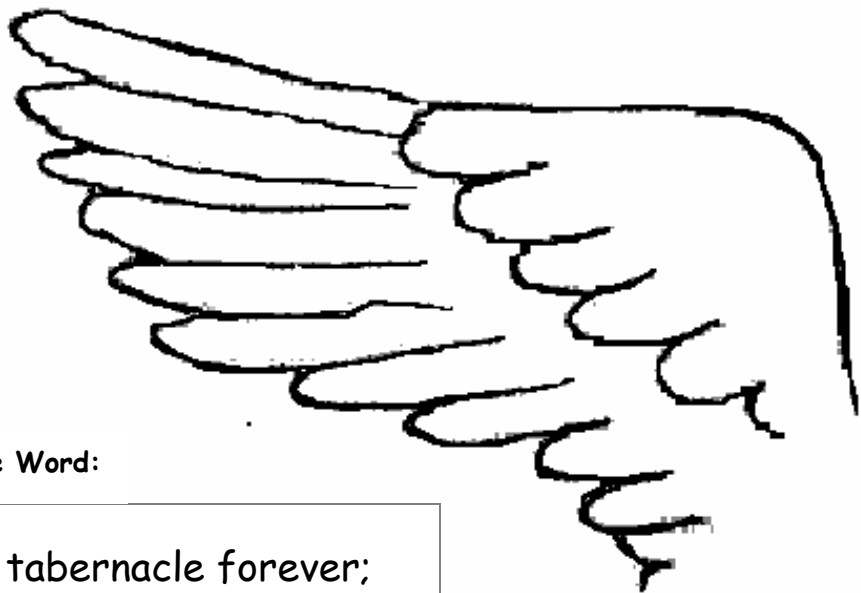
Materials

heavy white paper
scissors
glue
feathers
optional: colored paper for background for the wings **OR** ribbon for hanging the wings

Procedure

1. Draw a pair of wings on heavy white paper (or use the template below).
2. Carefully cut out the wings.
3. Apply glue to the wings, and then cover them with feathers.
4. Cut out the text slip below.
5. Glue the wings to another piece of paper and glue the text slip above it.
OR
6. Attach the two wings together and hang from ribbon (or a piece of yarn). The text slip can be glued onto the back of the wings or attached to the ribbon above the wings.
