



## LESSON 21 – CASCADE NEW CHURCH SUNDAY SCHOOL

Text: The Parable of the Good Samaritan – Luke 10:25-37

Recitation:

"Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I come again, I will repay you" (Luke 10:35).

Themes:

1. Discuss what it means to be a Good Samaritan.

Activities:

Bring simple costumes for each character and also a donkey head mask made out of brown paper and have the children act out the parable.

- a. Good Samaritan--needs donkey, oil and wine, clothes, bandages
- b. Journeyer--needs clothes that can be pulled off easily, money bag
- c. Robbers--masks? staves or clubs, clothing
- d. Levite--nice clothes, jewels and/or neck chain?
- e. Priest--nice clothes, jewels?

A possible project is that children have a "sling" or long white strip of "bandage" on which they can write "Be a Good Samaritan" or something like that. Then they can wear them.

Adaptation for Toddlers:

They can practice bandaging each other's "owies."
