

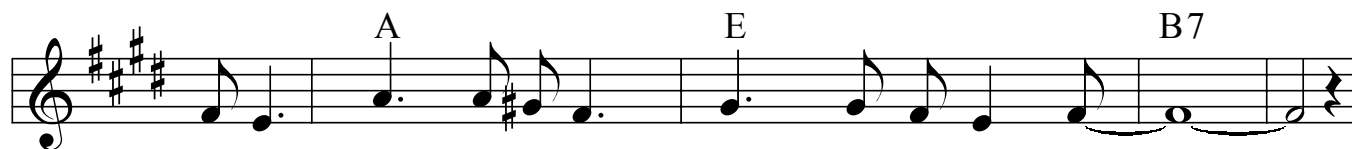
# The Good Samaritan

Based on Luke 10: 25-37

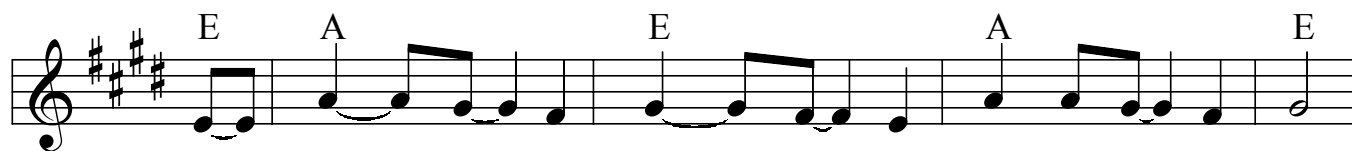

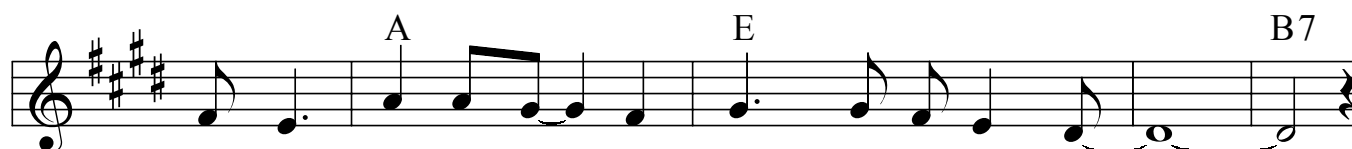
1. There came a man— down from Jer - u - sa - lem to Jer - i - cho,

 And he went to pay the keep - er of the inn. \_\_\_\_\_



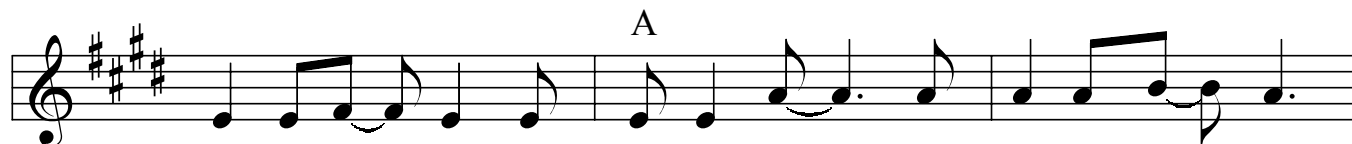
They stripped him of— his cloth - ing, and— they wound - ed him— half dead,
